BUSINESS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

MRF TYRES LISTED IN SCHEDULE E OF CAMS MANUAL

The Commission unanimously ratified a decision between meetings to allow the MRF tyre to be listed in Schedule E of CAMS Manual under approved tyres for tarmac and circuit racing competitions.

2B/2F LIST OF ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

The Commission unanimously ratified a decision between meetings to approve amendment of the “2B/2F List of eligible vehicles” to include Ford Mustang 6th Generation and SIN Car S1 550

AUSTRALIAN PROTOTYPE SERIES

The Commission unanimously ratified a decision between meetings to allow 6SR vehicles competing in the Australian Prototype Series to run carbon tub chassis, not just carbon reinforced.

Min 2740: SALOON CARS (GROUP 3K) REGULATIONS

Recognition documents continue to be Work in Progress for the Ford and Holden AU/VT models.

Min 2750: FORMULA FORD ALTERNATE CLUTCH DRIVE PLATE

The Commission approved a proposal to add an alternative clutch drive plate (No. CP4429-3FM4) to the current part number CP2012-166FM3, as there is a risk that without this superior alternative plate reliability of the vehicles will be compromised, as the current plate has experienced cracking with the resultant unreliability issues. The Commission determined that both plates are to be optional for use, and the availability of the alternative plate be effective immediately.
