BUSINESS ARRIVING FROM THE MINUTES

Approval of the 2021 Repco Supercars Championship Regulations. In recent years, the Championship has been an International Series with the FIA approving the regulations.

MIN 2983: Electric Vehicle Working Group (formerly minute 2962)

An update was provided on the EV Working Group's last meeting in December 2020, confirming the approval of the 2021 Electric Vehicle Standing Regulations. The publication of these regulations will meet with the timeline set out by the EVWG.

The Standing Regulations are designed to advise all involved in the sport and especially our volunteer officials, event organisers and competitors and develop strategies so that they can all receive sufficient training and advice related to EV participation in motorsport.

MIN 2979: Superlicence Update

An update was made to the AMRC regarding changes to the Superlicence points allocation. With S5000 being awarded the Australian Gold Star Award it's points allocation rose as a consequence. The absence of Formula 4 created a vortex in terms of junior development categories, which resulted in an increase points allocation to Toyota 86.

MIN 2980: AMRC Review:

A presentation was made to the AMRC detailing the current health of National and State Motor Racing Landscape, including statistical information on category health and survey information (from both category and association managers). The AMRC will review this information through 2021 and provide pathway proposals.
