AIMSS REPORT

The Commission noted that the Board has released a detailed summary of the Australian Institute of Motor Sport Safety's (AIMSS) review into rallying in Australia. Refer to CAMS website under News (15 January 2018).

MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES

The Commission ratified the following action between meetings:

Addition to 'NRCVG Article 4.10 – Fuel' to read:

“(a) Only the following fuels as defined by CAMS manual Schedule G are permitted in a Rally event:

- (i) Commercial Fuel; and
- (ii) Unleaded Racing Fuel.

(b) Where a specific rally group is further restricted to a defined fuel in their regulations, that restriction is also applied.

(c) Leaded Racing Fuel is not permitted.”

MIN 0387: 2018 ARC SPORTING AND TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

The 2018 ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations were approved for issue on the CAMS website on 25 January.

MIN 0388: CLUB RALLY CAR ELIGIBILITY FOR CLASSIC OUTBACK TRIAL

The revised National Rally Code lists Club Rally Cars as being ineligible for National Events, and following a presentation it was resolved to specifically permit these cars to be eligible for the 2018 Classic Outback Trial.

MIN 0390: JUNIOR DRIVER EXEMPTION – JOSH BOHM

The application for exemption under NRC 2.1 (d) for Josh Bohm was approved.
