### UPDATED DOCUMENTS

#### CAMS Manual Updates (live tracked manual/regulatory changes):

- National Rally Code (Permitted Fuel).
- Group 3C – Production Rally Cars (PRC) – inclusion of Excel Rally Cars Appendix.

#### 2018 ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations V2

V2 of the 2018 ARC Sporting and Technical Regulations was issued on 7 February, this version rectifying:

- Regulatory application of the registration process, as identified and agreed by ARCom – Driver to register.
- Appendix A - the usage of Signage A3 and some minor wording edits.
- Technical Regs – rectify error to Tyre Pattern Code for 13" tyre, and remove the 13" ZGM Tyre (reported as only to supply to suit Classic Escort).

### 50<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE AUSTRALIAN RALLY CHAMPIONSHIP (1968 to 2018)

CAMS is establishing plans to celebrate the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Australian Rally Championship (1968 – 2018). For those who would like to submit any ideas on what to include should be forwarded to John Murphy at CAMS, prior to a proposal being shortly presented to the Board.

### MATTERS ARISING FROM MINUTES

#### **MIN 0399: APRC – NATIONAL LICENCE REQUIREMENTS**

Commissioners agreed to a proposal for National Competitors to participate in the international component of the APRC on a National Rally Licence, provided they are not eligible to score APRC points. This is similar to that adopted by New Zealand where a New Zealand competitor can compete in the APRC field under a MSNZ National Permit and not collect APRC points.

#### **MIN 0400: COMMISSIONERS TO REPORT ON STATE ISSUES**

Although Commissioners do not specifically represent a State at the Commission meetings, a Commissioner is to be appointed to contact a State Rally Advisory Panel Chair to obtain comments or reports on any important information that affect (may affect) the Commission, and to improve communications (provide a direct line of communications) between the two organisations.

Some suggested information be on safety issues, events, vehicles, regulatory issues, general improvement on the sport, development of the sport, junior development; heavy emphasis to be on club and multi-club levels.
