### SUMMARY

#### MATTERS ARISING FROM PREVIOUS MINUTES

##### MIN 0559:

#### INVITATIONAL ENTRIES

An Information Paper was tabled, to discuss how Invitational Entries should be considered for Rally events and proposed what eligibility criteria should be considered when a vehicle is permitted to enter a rally event as an invitation vehicle.

The paper proposed that in each case an invited vehicle should be accepted only if it can be determined that the vehicle meets the minimum CAMS rally safety criteria required for entry to the event which includes:

- Safety cage structure;
- the use of the minimum apparel requirements including FHR;
- compliance with National Rally Code, Vehicles General; and
- compliance with CAMS Manual, General Requirements Schedule A and B.

The Commission discussed this matter briefly and noted there is a need for a proper structure which allows 'invitational' entries to compete and advised that CAMS Technical should declare final approvals on vehicle entries.
