Formula SAE is an international *Competition*, conceived by the Society of Automotive Engineers in the USA and now contested in a number of countries.

The Australian contest invites teams of tertiary students to design and build small formula-style racing cars. Restrictions are placed on the car frame and engine so the students' knowledge, creativity, and imagination are tested. Four-cycle engines up to 610 cc can be turbocharged or supercharged to add a new dimension to the challenge of engine design.

The vehicles are judged in 3 different categories:

- engineering design and static inspection,
- solo performance trials, and
- high-performance track endurance.

Motorsport Australia supports the Formula SAE *Competition* as an important initiative in the development of automotive talent and skills in Australia and has adopted the Formula SAE regulations by reference.
