

2024 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA NSW APRA CHAMPIONSHIP

1. PHILOSOPHY:

- (i) The intent of the following regulations is to enable competitors to adequately understand and be able to prepare for the 2024 race season. The APRA Australian Pulsar Racing Association is Championship will is aimed at Club level competitors as an entry level motorsport class operated under the Motorsport Australia guidelines and requirements.
- (ii) Our philosophy and aim are to provide a platform for our members to compete in a fun, friendly and fair manner both on and off the track

1.1 **DEFINITION:**

(i) The APRA Motorsport Australia Championship will be run in accordance with the 2024 Motorsport Austalia Manual, Circuit Race Appendix, Circuit Racing Standing Regulations and the 2024 Motorsport Australia Manual, National Competition Rules. See links below.

- (ii) These regulations apply to current financial members of the Australian Pulsar Racing Association (APRA) at the time of entering and/or participating in an event sanctioned by APRA.
- (iii) The regulations contained in this document are to be read and applied in conjunction with the following APRA regulations, procedures and policies;
 - APRA Technical Regulations
 - Driving Code of Conduct
 - Acceptable Social Media Usage Policy
 - Privacy Policy
 - Drugs and Alcohol Policy

2. ELIGIBILITY:

(i) To be eligible to enter any event sanctioned and/or organized by the Australian Pulsar Racing Association you must be a current financial member of APRA.

- (ii) To be eligible for the APRA Australian Pulsar Racing Association Championship, you must be a current financial member of APRA.
- (iii) Should a non-financial member wish to participate in a single event, a single event membership can be purchased. The cost and approval of a single event membership is at the discretion of the APRA Directors and will be determined on a case by case basis.

3. CALENDAR:

(i) The APRA NSW Championship will be run over 4 championship point scoring rounds as set out in the table below.

(ii) All APRA Technical and Sporting Regulations apply to the events listed in the table below.

4. SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP POINTS SYSTEM:

4.1 Points System

(i) Series championship points are allocated to drivers based on the finishing order in each race as per table 4.2.

(ii) A race will be declared as completed and points awarded based on the decision of the Clerk of Course and the organiser of that event.

- (iv) The final race at each event will be a "Trophy Race" and a trophy will be awarded to the top 3 outright finishers and top 3 masters competitors for that race
- (v) Competitors from other states can earn points in a single round of a NSW category event without needing registration, but participating in two or more rounds mandates registration

Note: Points will not be averaged out over the number of races at an event to equal 450 as has been done in the past.

5. CHAMPIONSHIP:

(i) The 2024 APRA NSW Outright Championship will be decided by who has accumulated the highest number of points across the 4 championship point scoring events.

- (iv) A minimum of 3 rounds must be completed to declare the 2024 APRA Motorsport Australia Champion.
- (vi) The round 4 event (TBA) may be an Endurance Event and will carry double points for each scheduled race.

7. CATEGORY SPONSOR SIGNAGE:

Category sponsor signage must be displayed on all cars as set out in the current APRA Technical Regulations at each event.

8. VEHICLE COMPLIANCE:

All vehicles competing must comply with the current APRA Technical Regulations.

9. VEHICLE WEIGHT:

All vehicles must comply with the minimum weight of 1100kg including driver as specified in the APRA Technical Regulations.

10. TYRE REGULATIONS:

Tyres must be fitted and utilised in accordance with the current APRA Technical Regulations and in conjunction with any event supplementary regulations.

11. IN-CAR CAMERA FOOTAGE AND SD CARDS:

A fully operational forward facing in-car camera and video recorder in accordance with the APRA Technical Regulations is compulsory.

12. PENALTY AND PROTEST SYSTEM:

(i) The APRA Motorsport Australia Championship will be run in accordance with the 2024 Motorsport Australia Manual, National Competition Rules. See link below.
