



Appendix I - 2019 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA SPORTS SEDAN CHAMPIONSHIP

I.1 CHAMPIONSHIP NAMING

The championship shall be officially known as the “2019 Motorsport Australia WA Sports Sedan Championship”.

I.2 CATEGORY ORGANISERS

The organisers of the championships shall be the WA Sports Sedan and Sports Car Association Inc (WASSSCA)

I.3 CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY

- (i) This Appendix is prepared in accordance with the 2019 Motorsport Australia Championship and Series Policy.
- (ii) The championship shall be a series of races open to all competitors with log booked vehicles who present their vehicle to compete in compliance with Motorsport Australia 3rd category GROUP 3D.
- (iii). Vehicles that are considered acceptable to compete by the organizers but do not comply with eligibility requirements will not be eligible to score points for the championship
- (iv) The organisers shall determine eligibility for each vehicle prior to the commencement of each race meeting.
- (v). The onus of proof of vehicle eligibility rests with each individual competitor

I.4 COMPETITION NUMBERS

The category organisers are responsible for issuing competition numbers to minimise duplication between all competitors

I.5 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

Vehicles must comply with the General Requirements of Automobiles (as applicable) in schedules A, B and C of the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Manual.

I.6 RACE FORMAT

The race format shall be as prescribed for Sprint races in the approved 2019 Motorsport Australia WA Race Championship Sporting Regulations 2.3 Grid Positions and/or event Supplementary Regulations.

- (i) Race 1 - From Qualifying times Fastest qualifier on pole
- (ii) Race 2 - REVERSE TOP 10. (ie: 10 Entrants, therefore top 10 in Race 1 are reverse grid, person who finishes 10th in Race 1 starts position 1, person who finishes 9th starts position 2 and so-on, and 11th onward as they finished Race 1) with non finishers and non starters to rear of grid.
- (iii) Race 3 - From finishing order of race 2
- (iv) Any Further races from finishing order of previous race

I.7 POINT SCORE

- (i). Points will be awarded for placegetters in all races.
- (ii) The championship shall be won by the driver accumulating the highest number of points throughout the series.
- (iii) The 2019 WA Race Championship Sporting Regulations 3.3 & 3.4 (i) Point Scores to be used.

I.8 CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY OFFICERS

The Category eligibility officers will be appointed by the category organisers. Interim or substitute. category eligibility officers may be added at any time by the category organisers.

I.9 DRIVING STANDARDS OBSERVERS

The driving standards observers will be appointed by the category organisers. Interim or substitute driving standard observers may be added at any time by the category organisers.

I.10 CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS AND POINTS

Rounds 1 - 8. Up to a maximum of the first 4 races will receive championship points.
