



## **Appendix J - 2020 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA 'CONTEMPORARY' FORMULA LIBRE RACE CAR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP**

### **J.1. OBJECTIVE**

The objective for the 2020 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA 'Contemporary' Formula Libre Race Car State Championship shall be to provide a competitive and exciting racing category for open wheel race cars complying with this Appendix and with the requirements outlined in the 2020 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Manual of Motorsport.

- (i) The championship shall be officially known as the "2020 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA Contemporary Formula Libre Championship". Hereinafter referred to as the Championship.

### **J.2. CATEGORY ORGANISERS**

### **J.3. ELIGIBILITY**

- 3.0 This Appendix is prepared in accordance with the 2020 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Championship and Series Policy.
- 3.1 Cars compliant with the applicable technical regulations and technical bulletins issued by MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA, and is open to all competitors whose vehicles comply with the 1<sup>st</sup> Category: Race Cars for Race Events as defined in the 2020 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Manual, to also include invited logbook cars by the promoter.
- 3.2 The category Technical Officer may request an inspection of any competing vehicle for compliance with eligibility rules.
- 3.3 Any eligibility inspections may be conducted by the Chief Scrutineer in accordance with any provisions of the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Manual, including but not limited to matters referred by the Technical Officer, whether under section 3.2 above or otherwise. Where a matter has been referred to the Chief Scrutineer the inspection shall be conducted in Parc Ferme following the next practice, qualifying or race session if it cannot be agreed with the competitor to conduct it prior to that. The Technical Officer may assist the Chief Scrutineer in any inspection if so requested by the organisers or the Chief Scrutineer.
- 3.4 At the conclusion of qualifying or racing, cars may be directed to Parc Ferme without first returning to their pit area and without having been interfered with. Cars may be impounded in the designated Parc Ferme and not must be removed or worked for any purpose without the permission of the Chief Scrutineer.

3.5 References in sections 3.2 to 3.4 to the Technical Officer and Chief Scrutineer shall be equally applied to the appointed delegates (in the case of the Technical Officer, this must be in writing).

#### **J.4. CHAMPIONSHIP & POINTSCORE**

4.1 The Championship will be open to all cars that run in this Championship with the highest aggregate score over all race meetings being declared as the champion. The 2020 WA Race Championship Sporting Regulations 3.3 & 3.4 (i) Point Scores to be used

#### **J.5. COMPETITION NUMBERS**

5.1 The number 1 shall be reserved for the sole use of the highest point's scorer from the previous year's Championship.

#### **J.6. RACE FORMAT**

6.1 The race format shall be as prescribed for Sprint races in the approved 2020 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA Race Championship Sporting Regulations 2.3 (i) Grid Positions.

#### **J.7. CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS & POINTS**

All Races at each round will receive championship points.
