1. INFECTIOUS DISEASES

Motorsport Australia requires that all those who are likely to come into contact with blood or body fluids use *Standard Precautions*. This includes circuit medical staff, flag marshals, and all trackside personnel who are likely to be involved in attending an incident. At a minimum, relevant individuals must be issued with disposable gloves.
