Required if the Log Book is needed within five working days of application being received by Motorsport Australia. This does not include the Australia Post Express delivery time.
Priority Fee is in addition to the logbook fee.

Safety Cage Registration Form

Each vehicle that is required to be fitted with a safety cage must have the Safety Cage Registered by Motorsport Australia as compliant with the Motorsport Australia Manual or otherwise issued with a relevant, Motorsport Australia approved Safety Cage Certificate. If the safety cage has not been registered or is not issued with a Motorsport Australia approved cage certificate, then this must be included with the Log Book Application.

A Safety Cage may be registered/certified prior to a Motorsport Australia Log Book application.

Vehicle Photograph Requirements

Vehicle photographs MUST comply with the following requirements in order to be approved:

- Digital format full colour, focus, resolution and of a professional quality (1MB or larger)
- Must be in COMPLETE race condition/competition ready (no missing parts or components)
- Must be devoid of additional objects in the background (such as workshop equipment) and must be only of the vehicle itself
