



Appendix B - 2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA Formula Vee State Championship

B.1 OBJECTIVE

- (i) The objective of the 2025 Motorsport Australia WA Formula Vee State Championship is to promote and foster the competition of Formula Vee racing cars complying with the Motorsport Australia 1st Category – Racing Cars Formula Vee regulations.
- (ii) The Championship shall be officially known as the WA Formula Vee State Championship.

B.2 CATEGORY ORGANISERS

- (i) The Category Organiser of the *Championship* shall be the Formula Vee Association of WA (FVAWA) Committee, herein referred to as “The Organiser”.

B.3 ELIGIBILITY

- (i) All vehicles must comply with the Formula Vee 1600cc and 1200cc rules as defined in the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA *Manual*.
- (ii) This Appendix is prepared in accordance with the 2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Championship and Series Policy.
- (iii) Each *Automobile* competing in the *Championship* shall have a current MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA logbook. Engine and gearbox sealing cards may be required to be presented at any time during the competition on request by the Category Eligibility Officer or by the Chief Scrutineer of the event.
- (iv) At the conclusion of *Championship* qualifying or races, *Automobiles* can expect to be directed to parc ferme by officials without returning to the pits or paddock, and without having been interfered with. Such *Automobiles* shall remain under the control of the Chief Scrutineer until released. *Drivers* may also be directed to the scrutineering bay prior to qualifying or a race for checks.
- (v) Any competing *Automobile* may be impounded at the discretion of the Chief Scrutineer.
- (vi) Any inspections shall be conducted by the Chief Scrutineer as listed on the *Event's Supplementary Regulations* or official delegated by the Chief Scrutineer or anyone else with authority outlined in NCRs or Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CRSR) in accordance with the provisions of the Formula Vee Technical Manual and the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA *Manual*. A Category Eligibility Officer, or representative, as appointed by the Organiser and ratified by the Western Australia Motor Race Advisory Panel (WAMRAP), will be on hand and able to assist the Chief Scrutineer.
- (vii) The Eligibility Officers are the Technical Directors as listed in the Committee on the FVAWA website.

B.4 CLASS DEFINITION

- (i) Classes for the championship shall be as follows:
 - a. 1600cc Formula Vee racing cars
 - b. 1200cc Formula Vee racing cars

B.5 COMPETITION NUMBERS

- (i) The number “1” shall be reserved for the sole use of the 2024 winner of the 1600 or 1200 championship at the discretion of The Organiser.
- (ii) The competition numbers on the *Automobiles* must comply with Schedule K of the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA manual, with an alternate option as listed at Clause 11 of the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA *Manual Circuit Race Appendix 1st Category – Racing Cars Formula Vee – Technical Regulations*.

B.6 GRID DETERMINATION

There will be one qualifying and up to 5 races at each *Round*.

- (i) First Race – from qualifying times, fastest qualifier to pole.
- (ii) Second Race – in the finishing order from Race 1.
- (iii) Third Race – in the finishing order from Race 2.
- (iv) Fourth Race – in the finishing order from Race 3.
- (v) Fifth Race – in the finishing order from Race 4 All starts will be standing starts.

B.7 CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS AND POINTS

- (i) Up to a maximum of 5 races per round will receive championship points.
- (ii) Points will be allocated in each class as per the 2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA State Circuit Racing Championship Sporting and Series Regulations.
- (iii) A *Driver* must delete any 3 races from their *Championship* results, which may include non-entered events.
