



# Appendix E - 2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA EXCEL CUP STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

### **E.1 ELIGIBILITY & NAMING**

- (i) This Appendix is prepared in accordance with the 2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Championship and Series Policy, the Motorsport Australia National Competition Rules (NCR) and the Circuit Race Standing Regulations (CRSR).
- (ii) The championship shall be officially known as the "2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA Excel Cup State Championship".
- (iii) The championship shall be a series of races open to all competitors with log booked vehicles who present their vehicle to compete in compliance with the Circuit Race Appendix 3<sup>rd</sup> Category -Touring Cars Group 3E Circuit Excel technical regulations as defined in the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA *Manual*.

# **E.2 CATEGORY ORGANISERS**

- (i) The Category Organisers of the championships shall be the WA Excel Cup Association herein referred to as "the Organisers".
- (ii) The Category Organiser's contact is 'Darren Seaton', email darren.seaton@westrac.com.au.

# **E.3 CATEGORY ELIGIBILITY OFFICERS**

(i) The Category Eligibility Officer will be appointed by the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA Motor Race Advisory Panel (WAMRAP). Interim or substitute Category Eligibility Officers may be added at any time by the Category Organisers which is to be ratified by WAMRAP, and the relevant Event Organisers and the Clerk of the Course are to be advised.

## **E.4 DRIVING STANDARDS ADVISERS**

(i) The Driving Standards Adviser may be appointed by the relevant Event Organisers of each Event. Interim or substitute Driving Standard Advisers may be added at any time by the Category Organisers, which must be ratified by WAMRAP, who then advise the Event Organisers and Clerk of the Course of the Event.

#### **E.5 COMPETITION NUMBERS**

- (i) The Category Organisers are responsible for issuing competition numbers to minimise duplication between all competitors.
- (ii) The number 1 shall be reserved for the sole use of the 1<sup>st</sup> placed *Driver* of the previous year's State Championship should they wish to use it.

#### E.6 CLASSES AND STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

- (i) There are two recognised classes within the Excel category:
  - Trophy (Outright)
  - Masters
- (ii) Both classes will have a recognised state championship, known as:
  - Trophy State Championship
  - Masters State Championship
- (iii) All Drivers must nominate which state championship they will compete in, with the nomination provided to the Category Organisers.
- (iv) It is the responsibility of the Category Organiser to advise the relevant Event Organiser with the required information no later than 24 hours after the entry closing date or the closing of the late entries date as listed in the supplementary regulations, whichever occurs later.
- (v) To be eligible for the Masters State Championship, the Driver must be over 40 years of age at the start of the season.
- (vi) A Driver may choose to swap between state championships within the year, but state championship points awarded in one state championship cannot be transferred to another.
- (vii) For a class to be awarded state championship points, a minimum of 8 entries must be received and commence qualifying.
- (viii) For a Driver to be awarded state championship points, they must complete a minimum of 4 state championship rounds.

## E.7 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- (i) Automobiles must comply with the Technical Appendix (as applicable) in schedules A, B and C of the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Manual.
- (ii) Eligible *Automobiles* shall compete for the State Championship with Control Tyres as listed in the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Circuit Race Appendix 3<sup>rd</sup> Category -Touring Cars Group 3E Circuit Excel technical regulations.
- (iii) Fuel Sample point to be fitted as listed in the MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA Circuit Race Appendix 3<sup>rd</sup> Category -Touring Cars Group 3E Circuit Excel technical regulations.
- (iv) Raceceivers are to be fitted to all cars.
  - a These operate on Channel 001, 450.0000mhz.
  - b Direct communication may be made from Race Control to each *Driver* as may be required during each session at an *Event*.
  - c A Radio Check may be made when *Drivers* are in the Marshalling Area and *Drivers* must acknowledge with a "thumbs up" through their open window.
  - d Minimum communication will be at least alert to "Track Open" whilst in the Marshalling Area, "Last Lap", and "Chequered Flag".
  - e Any radio communication from Race Control to a *Driver* is not regulatory and cannot override the trackside flag signals or start signals. Communication from Race Control must be concise and stated at least twice. Examples are "Delayed Start or Aborted Start Go around", "Stalled Car stalled car!" and position if possible, "Yellow Flag Turn ?", "Oil on track Turn ?", "Slow Car between ?", "Red Flag return to ?", "Safety Car", "Black Flag Car No X"

#### E.8 RACE FORMAT

(i) Race 1:

As listed in 2025 MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA WA State Circuit Racing Championships Sporting and Series Regulations S9 Grid Determination.

(ii) Race 2

The format will be on the finishing order of Race 1.

(iii) Race 3:

The format will be determined by combining the points from Race 1 and Race 2, with the highest points scorer advancing to the pole.

(iv) Race 4:

On the finishing order of Race 3.

# **E.9 CHAMPIONSHIP ROUNDS AND POINTS**

- (i) State Championship points for both State Championships will be awarded per 2025 Motorsport Australia WA State Circuit Racing Championship Sporting and Series Regulations.
- (ii) The Category Organisers also recognise additional club championships of which Drivers must be financial members of the WA Excel Cup Association to participate. Further information can be found on the Category Organiser's website.
