Formula Ford

- The majority of stakeholder consultations on the proposed technical specifications of the new Formula Ford have been positive.

Amendment to NCR 113

The proposed change to the definition of 'Club Competition' in the National Competition Rules (NCR) 113 for immediate application and publication from 16 February, 2022.

National Stewards Appointments

The 2022 National Stewards Appointments as proposed were accepted.

Composition of AMRC

The Commission Standing Orders, version: 2.06 were amended - article 4 (b) (ii) as follows; "a maximum minimum of four (4) and a maximum of five (5) Commissioners with the appropriate suite of skills to undertake the functions assigned to the Commission" and Matt Braid was reappointed as a fifth member of the AMRC for a term of three years commencing in 2022.
