STEWARDS SUMMARY OF JUDICIAL OUTCOMES, Update 2: FINAL issued Sunday 7 July 2024 at 1715hrs.

Matters from Race 14:

Incident Determinations

The following Incidents were reviewed in conjunction with the DSA and it was determined the Incident did not warrant further investigation:

- The Incident on Lap 1 involving contact between Car 87 and Car 20 at Turn 2.5.
- The Incident on Lap 1 involving Car 87 and Car 4 at Turn 8.
- The allegation from PremiAir Pty Ltd that Car 26 had moved under braking into Turn 11 on Lap 7 and impeded Car 31.

Stewards' Decisions – Penalties imposed

Following a report from Supercars Technical that Erebus Motorsport Pty Ltd had, in breach of Rule D13.5.1.10, failed to upload data from Cars 1 and 9 following Qualifying for Race 14 to the designated address within the prescribed time, a post-session DRD investigation and an admission by Erebus Motorsport Pty Ltd of breaching the Rules, the Stewards imposed fines totalling \$1,000 on Erebus Motorsport Pty Ltd (a fine of \$500 for each breach).

SATURDAY 6 JULY 2024

Matters from Race 13:

Incident Determinations

The following Incidents were reviewed in conjunction with the DSA and it was determined the Incident did not warrant further investigation:

- The Incident involving Car 1, Brodie Kostecky, Car 11, Anton de Pasquale, and Car 10, Nick Percat, on Lap 1 between Turns 2 and 3.
- The Incident involving Car 1, Brodie Kostecky, and Car 12, Jaxon Evans, at Turn 3 on Lap 1.
- The Incident involving contact between Car 26, Richie Stanaway, and Car 20, David Reynolds, at Turn 4 on Lap 29.

- The allegation from Triple Eight Race Engineering Pty Ltd that Car 9, Jack Le Brocq, left the Circuit at Turn 8 and gained an advantage on Lap 83.

Stewards' Decisions – Penalties imposed

The Stewards imposed the following penalties in the Race:

- A 15 second Time Penalty on Car 96, Macauley Jones, for a Driving Infringement (causing a collision with Car 4, Cameron Hill, at Turn 13 on Lap 1).

After the Race, the Stewards conducted Hearings into 2 separate Incidents amounting to breaches of Rule D7.11 (Each Car must be completely free of all hoses, tools, Team Members and any other equipment at any time whilst the Car is moving) and after admission of the facts and the breaches by the relevant Competitor, imposed a penalty of the loss of 30 Teams Championship points and a fine of \$1500 in each case on:

- Matt Stone Racing Pty Ltd – a Team Member was still holding on to a component of Car 4 as it was being released from a Pit Stop.
- PremiAir Pty Ltd – a Jump Battery was left in Car 23 when it was released from its Pit Garage after a lengthy stop for repair.
