Administrative Procedures

Vehicle Preparation

1. Fill out Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure 'Application to Build a Motorsport Australia Dedicated Rally Vehicle' and submit to their Regency Park Office, or Post to :

Allow 2 weeks for Statement of Requirements to be sent to you. A copy of that approval will also be sent to Motorsport Australia

2. Contact Motorsport Australia accredited scrutineers to make an appointment for a rally vehicle inspection.

3. Once passed by the Scrutineer make an appointment with the Vehicle Inspection Station, Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure, Regency Park to have your rally vehicle inspected. A fee will be charged by the Department. Allow 2 hours for the inspection.

4. Take the following with you to both the scrutineers inspection and Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure Inspection:

- Motorsport Australia licence, log book and club membership card
- Homologation papers and/or workshop manuals
- Motorsport Australia letter of introduction
- Motorsport Australia scrutineer's report form
- Completed Roll Over Certification form if roll cage does not comply with specifications in current Motorsport Australia or FIA manuals
- Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government. Vehicle Import Approval if vehicle is imported (Note: not required at Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure inspection as this would have been supplied prior to the issue of a Statement of Requirements)
- Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure Statement of Requirements
- Engineers' reports covering special modifications, eg. Steering, roll cage and brake hoses

Note: If your rally vehicle is currently not registered in South Australia a Vehicle Identification inspection will be conducted at the same time as the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure inspection. This is to verify engine and VIN/chassis numbers.

5. A Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure 'Certificate of Exemption' will be forwarded to the registered owner of the rally vehicle and a copy to Motorsport Australia.
6. Send the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure 'Certificate of Exemption' to Motorsport Australia, for log book notation and Motorsport Australia stamp.
7. When the Rally Vehicle has passed the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure inspection, a Dedicated Rally Vehicle plate will be supplied by Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (in the same way as an ADR compliance plate).
